Presentation by Professor Tim McCormack



Professor Tim McCormack will speak about the current Gaza crisis and in particular the role of the International Court of Justice and the International Criminal Court

Professor of International Law at the University of Tasmania and the Special Adviser on War Crimes to the Prosecutor of the International Criminal Court in The Hague, Tim graduated from the University of Tasmania with honours in Law in 1982 and completed his PhD in International Law at Monash University in 1990. He was the inaugural Australian recipient of the Golda Meir Postdoctoral Fellowship to the Hebrew University of Jerusalem and has developed a global reputation for his expertise in international humanitarian law and in international criminal law. Tim was a National Vice-President of Australian Red Cross (1999-2002) and chair of the Australian Red Cross National Advisory Committee on International Humanitarian Law (1994-2002). He was awarded the Australian Red Cross Medal for Outstanding Volunteer Service in 2001 and the Australian Red Cross Distinguished Service Medal in 2014 for more than 20 years of voluntary commitment to the promotion of understanding of and respect for International Humanitarian Law. He has participated in multiple Australian Government delegations to multilateral treaty negotiations in New York, Geneva, The Hague and Rome and he has provided expert international law advice to a number of Australian Government departments.
